<sup>1</sup> Days are reckoned as beginning on the first date at sundown and ending on the second date at sundown. The scriptural new year begins with the new moon of Abib from Jerusalem as stated in Isaiah 2:3, "...for out of Zion will the law go forth, and the word of Yahweh from Jerusalem." The new moon can be predetermined as per examples in 1 Sam., 20:5 & 18. Abib 1 is the beginning of Year 22 of the 70th Jubilee cycle calculated from the time that the Israelites observed the first Jubilee cycle in 1386/1385 B.C.E in the land of Kaanan. The Exodus occurred in 1439/1438 B.C.E.

<sup>2</sup> Passover Day begins on the 14th day of Abib and is Day 1 of the 7-day Festival of Passover/Unleavened Bread. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Ex. 12:6 – 20, 13:3–10, 34:18; Lev. 23:5, 23:7; Num. 9:2 – 3, 28:16 – 25; Deut. 16:1–4, Ezekiel 45:21; Matt. 26:17; Mark 14:12; Luke 22:7.

<sup>3</sup> The day after the weekly Sabbath of Passover Week/Unleavened Bread. Listed to determine Pentecost. Lev. 23:9–11 This year the Wave Sheaf Offering falls on the sixth day of Passover Week.

<sup>4</sup> Festival Day 6 of the 7-day Festival of Passover/Unleavened Bread. Not a High Sabbath or Sacred Convocation. Lev. 23:6; Num. 28:16 – 25, 33:3–4.

<sup>5</sup> Festival Day 7 and last day of the 7-day Festival of Passover/Unleavened Bread. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Ex. 12:16, 13:6–7; Lev. 23:8; Num. 28:16–25; Deut. 16:8.

<sup>6</sup> Fiftieth day from the Wave Sheaf Offering. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Note: the Siwan date will change with the Gregorian date from year to year. Ex. 23:16, 34:22; Lev. 23:15–16; Deut. 16:9.

<sup>7</sup> First day of seventh month. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Lev. 23:23–25; Num. 29:1.

<sup>8</sup> Tenth day of seventh month. A day of fasting. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Lev. 16:29–31, 23:26–32; Num. 29:7.

<sup>9</sup> The first day of the 8-day Festival of Ingathering. This day along with the next 6, which make up the first 7 days of the Festival of Ingathering, are also referred to as the Festival of Tabernacles. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Ex. 23:16, 34:22; Lev. 23:33–39; Num. 29:12; Deut. 16:13; John 7:10.

<sup>10</sup> The last day (Last Great Day) of the 8-day Festival of Ingathering. Also this day as well as the entire Festival is referred to as the Festival of Ingathering. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Ex. 23:16; Lev. 23:36, 23:39; Num. 29:35; Neh. 8:18; John 7:37.
